HIST4336 - The U.S. Jewish Experience

<u>HIST 4336</u> The U.S. Jewish Experience (3 semester hours) This course will explore the creation and evolution of American Jewish culture and investigate the impact of successive waves of migration upon the making of American Jewry. Students will study the process of cultural renewal and religious reform, assimilation, anti-Semitism, American Jewish responses to the Great Depression, the Holocaust, and the interaction between Israel and American Jewish communities in the postwar period. Prerequisite: <u>HIST 1301</u> or <u>HIST 1302</u> or <u>HIST 2301</u> or <u>HIST 2330</u> or <u>HIST 2331</u> or equivalent. (3-0) T
