

# FERM6V98 - Financial Engineering and Risk Management Internship

[FERM 6V98](#) Financial Engineering and Risk Management Internship (1-3 semester credit hours)  
Student gains experience and improves skills through appropriate developmental work assignments in a real business environment. Student must identify and submit specific business learning objectives at the beginning of the semester. The student must demonstrate work on significant projects. At semester end, student prepares an assignment reflecting on the work experience. Student performance is evaluated by the work supervisor. Pass/Fail only. May be repeated for credit as topics vary (3 semester credit hours maximum). ([1-3]-0) R
