UNIV3075 - Intermediate University Engagement and Applied Leadership II

<u>UNIV 3075</u> Intermediate University Engagement and Applied Leadership II (0 semester credit hours) This is a required course for all students selected to serve as second-year mentors in the AES Freshman Mentor Program. We live in a time of unique social contexts and continuous change. This dynamic presents several potential challenges and necessary adjustments for young adults as they transition to the independence and period or personal development that occurs in college. This class provides the administrative structure and resources for the Freshman Mentor Program and is a continuation of <u>UNIV 3074</u> - Introductory University Engagement and Applied Leadership I. Weekly topics along with monthly discussions will afford second-year mentors an opportunity to develop a deeper understanding of the importance of university engagement and leadership from an applied perspective. Second-year mentors will continue and build upon required discussion group participation through deliverables related to specified learning outcomes. Credit/No Credit only. May be repeated up to three times. Instructor consent required. (2-0) Y
