COMM3350 - Intercultural Communication

<u>COMM 3350</u> Intercultural Communication (3 semester credit hours) Examines how culture is studied and how culture affects self-concept, reasoning and patterns of thought, verbal and nonverbal communication, and communication style. Additional topics include intercultural conflict, ethnocentrism and prejudice, intercultural accommodation and adjustment, and intercultural business protocol. Prerequisites: (<u>RHET 1302</u> and <u>COMM 1311</u>) or instructor consent required. (3-0) Y
