SOC3381 - Field Research Methods

<u>SOC 3381</u> Field Research Methods (3 semester credit hours) This course introduces students to field research, the principal methodology of qualitative research. Students learn how to make observations and conduct interviews, and how to record and analyze data collected through these field methods. While students do not conduct actual research, they will complete a series of practice exercises to develop an individual research proposal. The proposal will be the basis of the research project students will undertake in the follow-up field research course, <u>SOC 4317</u> or <u>PA 4317</u> Field Research Practicum.
