Topics covered include fundamental skills, as well as selected experiments developed in a traditional two-semester Introductory Organic Chemistry Laboratory sequence ([CHEM 2123](#) and [CHEM 2125](#)). Required course for students in the Partnership in Advancing Clinical Transition (UT-PACT) Program. May not be used to fulfill degree requirements for pre-health majors. Lab fee of \$30 required. Corequisites: [CHEM 2330](#) and instructor consent required. (0-4) Y
